All our music ensembles are returning in September! Each ensemble has its own rehearsal schedule and will contribute to worship on Sunday every 3-4 weeks. These ensembles will all rotate between 8:30 and 11am worship, so everyone will get a chance to hear each of our wonderful groups. All are invited to join for rehearsal and worship as often as you are able – no long-term commitment necessary. Joyful Noise children's choir consists of two groups: Good News (K-2nd grade) and New Song (3rd-6th grade). We will be meeting every Wednesday from 4:45-6pm, with our first rehearsal on Wednesday, September 14. We'll have games, crafts and lots of fun activities as well as of course - singing! There is still room in both age groups, so contact Dr. Zach if you're not yet signed up!

Praise Band will rehearse on Wednesdays at 6pm for a week or two prior to leading worship on a Sunday, then take a week or two off. Our first rehearsal is Wednesday, September 14, to prepare for 11am worship on September 18. Praise Band is open to singers and instrumentalists of all ages and skill levels. We love to incorporate new sounds and ideas into this ensemble, so if you're hiding a latent talent for accordion, bagpipes, jaw harp, or anything else, this could be your opportunity!

Sanctuary Choir is returning this fall! This mixed-voice choral ensemble will prepare anthems (traditional and new), psalms, hymns, and descants to lead worship roughly once a month. We will rehearse on Wednesdays at 7pm, usually for two weeks prior to leading worship on a Sunday, then take a couple weeks off. Our first rehearsal is Wednesday, September 14, preparing to sing for 11am worship on September 25. Please let Dr. Zach know if you'd like to be a part of this ensemble!

Bell Choir will continue to rehearse every Monday at 7pm, starting September 12, and will ring for worship every few weeks. No prior ringing experience is necessary to join, just a sense of rhythm and a willingness to learn. Bell ringing is great exercise for both the mind and body, keeping us all quick-witted and nimble-wristed! Please confirm your plans to be in Bell Choir with Dr. Zach, even if you've rung with us before, so we can be sure to set out enough bells for everyone!

Chamber Choir is a small, upper-level, auditioned ensemble that leads worship once month. More demanding than Sanctuary Choir, this group of advanced singers explores a wide variety of sacred choral repertoire. Please contact Dr. Zach if you would like to schedule an audition.
